



RHUMC: SIERRA SERVICE PROJECT FUNDRAISING 2023

Fundraising is an essential part of the SSP experience. Youth and their families pay tuition to Sierra Service Project, however, the rest of the funding for travel and transportation (rental cars, gas, accommodations, etc.) is paid for with the funds raised throughout the year.

As a youth attending SSP with Rolling Hills UMC, **you are required to participate in the letter writing campaign, and four additional fundraising events.**

Letter Writing #1: Please bring names and addresses for seven family members or friends who would be potentially interested in financially supporting our SSP mission trip. All the materials will be provided, however youth are responsible for assembling the letters (Youth only need to attend one of the letter writing events). Youth must complete their seven letters by March 1, 2023 or buy out of the letter writing campaign with a \$200 donation made to RHUMC.

Letter Writing #2: Please bring names and addresses for seven family members or friends who would be potentially interested in financially supporting our SSP mission trip. May 13, 2023 (Saturday) at 9:00 - 10:30am

Assembling Mother's Day Flowers: Youth will participate in an assembly line creating the Mother's Day flower arrangements. Please bring gardening gloves and pruning shears if you have them.

May 14, 2023 (Sunday)

Distributing Mother's Day Flowers: Youth will distribute Mother's Day flowers to those who pre-ordered, and will sell any remaining arrangements 8:00 -11:30am, or 5:00 - 6:00pm.

June 4, 2023 (Sunday)

Bake Sale: Provide baked goods and/or help sell the desserts following the 8:30am, 10:00am, or 5:30pm services. Please package desserts ahead of time in easy to sell individual portions.
